Halting the spread of coronavirus: a necessity

"It's about stopping the spread of the new coronavirus where there is a high probability of infection."

Remote Work: a challenge to be overcome... but how?

In France, of 18.2 million private sector workers, 5.2 million are telecommuting on a regular basis and are satisfied. From now on, 29% of the workforce of companies with more than 10 employees. When a company proposes working from home, according to the latest statistics, 30% of workers are favourable. And those responsible are experiencing an increase in productivity that is not negligible.
